

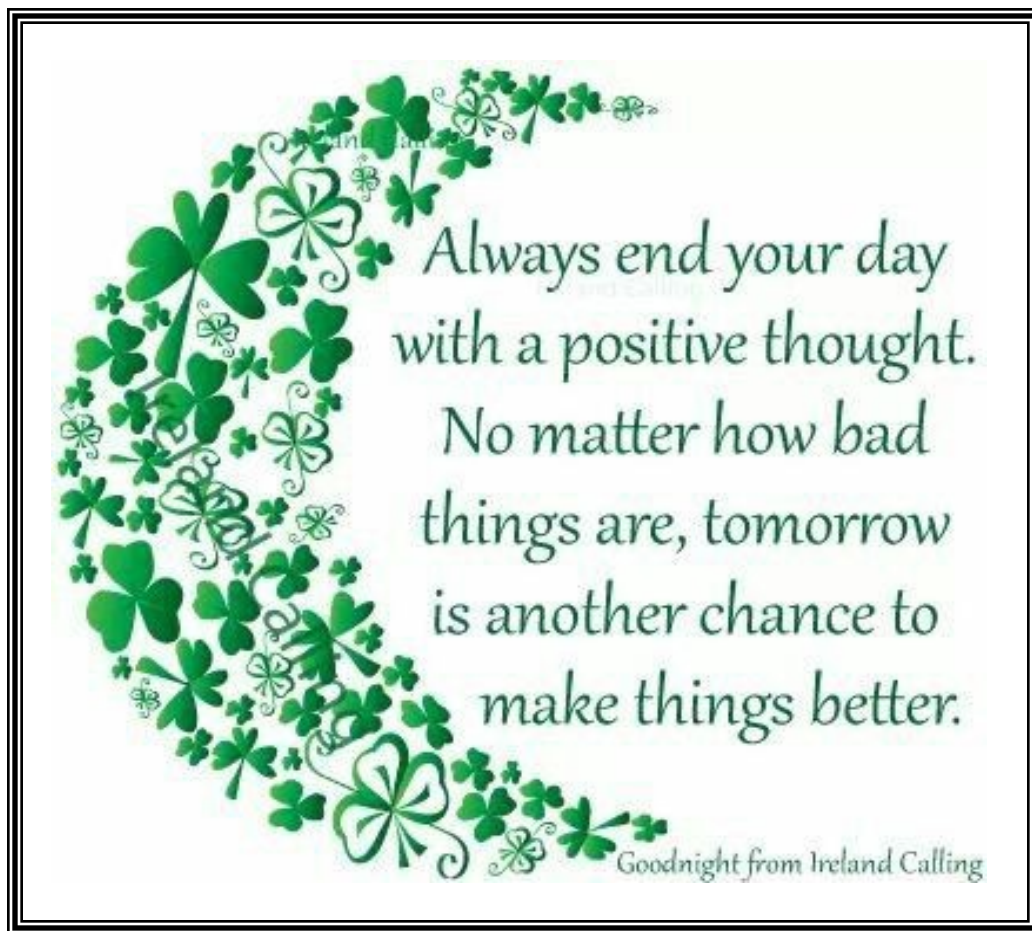

Sharon enjoys rock music especially classic rock. Her favorite station is WKLH.

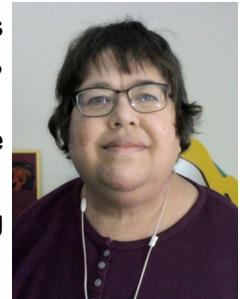
