



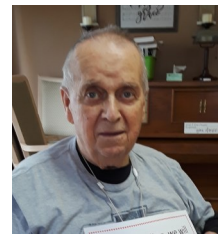

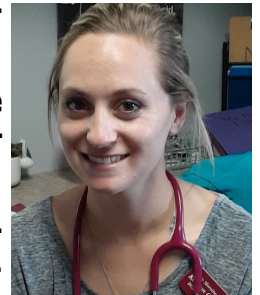
Welcome to our Newest Management Team Member Katelyn Otten, RN
