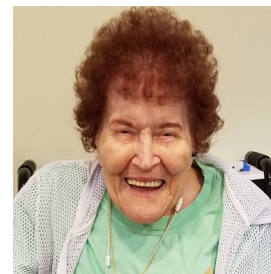
### Resident of the Month - Marie Cochran

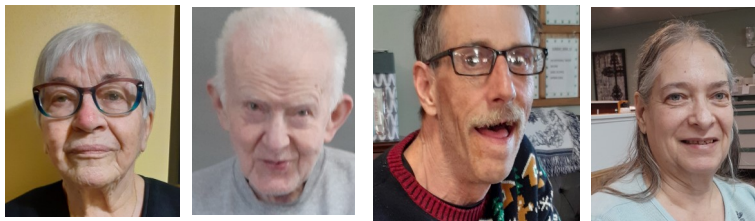
